Dear Sir.

I have not heard of the contemplated change in your regiment which you speak of, and trust that we may have the pleasure and profit of your continuance in the Service. With regard to the Guerrilla parties in Bates County, I will endeavour to check them as soon as I get more specific instructions from department Head Quarters. At present I scarcely dare venture to detach my Cavalry very far as I am expecting marching orders for them. Will you have the kindness to instruct your adjutant to inform me fully of the orders to report, to whom, and where which the companies of your regmt[.] have that are now stationed at Aubrey[.]
